Policy Statement

Several UMass programs provide tutoring and other academic services. These include LDSS, DS, Bilingual Collegiate Program, CCEBMS, Center for Asian Students, the Athletic Department.

If you qualify for services from one of these programs, and feel that you are in need of tutoring or other academic services, you are encouraged to seek their assistance. For information about these programs, see your TA.

However, you are also encouraged to take advantage of the services offered by the Phil 100A staff. Every member of the staff has office hours that are listed in the syllabus. We are also willing to meet with you by appointment if our office hours are inconvenient. We provide lectures, handouts, discussion sections, studyguides, and review sessions prior to quizzes.

If you take advantage of the services of LDSS, DS, BCP, CCEBMS, or any other UMass program, *you must inform your TA before you start getting tutoring*. Tell him or her which program you are working with, and what services they are providing to you. Even if you are receiving extensive tutoring from some outside program, *you must continue to attend lectures, discussions, and reviews*.
